I am writing to urge you to reexamine the allegations that have been made against Father Frank Pavone using the Matthew 18 model. I prayerfully ask you to examine them through the lenses of honesty, integrity and honor that so many of us have witnessed in Father Pavone. In all the information that has been released to date, I have not seen any indication that the facts support the allegations made. In fact it appears there is no documented evidence of wrongdoing and I urge you to restore Father Pavone to his post, releasing him to rejoin us on the battlefield for life.

One of the strategies enumerated in Sun Zu's Art of War is to *cause division among them*. Sun Zu recognized that a kingdom or house divided against itself cannot stand (Mark 3:24-25) and he urged armies to divide their enemies if they could. Father Frank Pavone, one of the generals in the fight for life, has fallen victim to this strategy. As those who are pro-abortion bring ridicule and accusations against him, they recognize that the removal of his leadership and voice from the battlefield would be a blow to the pro-life community and they applaud the actions that have been taken against this effective leader.

Under his leadership we took freedom rides, drawing attention to the depopulation effects of abortion in communities of color. Using his voice to sound the alarm across main stream America, Father Pavone has served as a source of unity, bringing organizations together without regard to denomination, ethnicity or divisive ideologies. Because of his willingness to openly lead in exposing the evils of the abortion industry as it takes innocent lives and hurts women, his work is bearing fruit - America is no longer willing to accept, blindly, the dogma that has been promoted by abortionists for the last 38 years. It is that fruit that has the pro-abortion community up in arms, willing to go to extreme lengths to silence his voice.
